MEMBERSHIP

New membership to Castlewood's Country Club requires a \$1,000.00 initiation fee. **That initiation fee will be waived with a twenty-four (24) month agreement of membership.** Member agrees to pay all account balances when due. I understand that if my account is not paid during the month issued then I will be charged a \$10 late fee per month thereafter. If my account balance becomes sixty (60) days past due, my membership privileges will be suspended until the account is brought current. Member will be responsible for all attorney fees and costs incurred by Castlewoods Country Club if collection proceedings are undertaken to obtain amounts owed to the club. Castlewoods Country Club is non-equity, private club owned by Castlewoods Intermed Company, LLC. Membership privileges to the Club are subject to the Rules and Regulations established by the Owners.

The Member assumes all risks for their use of the club, and by signing below, agrees that Castlewoods Country Club and its members will not be held liable for any loss, injury or damage to person or property related to the use of the club by the Member, his/her guest(s) or family members. Regardless of the use of funds paid by persons granted membership privileges, all ownership of the golf course and other Club facilities and the operation thereof is and will remain vested solely in the Owners. I do accept responsibility for the reasonable care of Club facilities and equipment in their use by me, my family and guests. Castlewoods Country Club reserves the right to terminate the membership of any member for failure to comply with the rules, regulations and policies of Castlewoods Country Club or for any conduct which the ownership determines to be improper or against the best interest of Castlewoods Country Club.

RESIGNATION

I may resign from the Club by giving **ninety days advance written notice** to the Club and by paying any dues or other charges which I may be liable for. No proration of dues for a partial month or initiation fees will be refundable to a member resigning from the Club. No cancellations/resignations shall be retroactive. **If I, as the new member chose to waive the initial initiation fee of \$1000.00, I then agree to remain a member in good standing for a period of twenty-four consecutive months. Should I resign or suspend my monthly dues obligation before the twenty-four month period has expired, I shall be responsible for the greater of the remainder of the agreed twenty-four month terms of membership owed or the full waived initiation fee of \$1,000.00.** At the end of the twenty-four month agreement, the membership will automatically renew unless a ninety (90) day notice of cancellation is received in writing from member prior to the expiration of the agreement or anytime thereafter.

BASIC POLICIES

- Players shall repair ball marks on the greens and sanding all divots. Bunkers shall be raked after use.
- A dress code for golfers is always enforced. Proper attire for the golf course and practice areas is required. Swim attire, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, mid and cut off shorts are not allowed. Judgement concerning questionable attire not covered here is left to the golf staff.

Teams are formed based on handicap and the cost is \$10 per player. The group with the lowest net and gross wins the pot. Registration in the pro shop is required at least 30 minutes before tee off. This group is a great way to meet other club members.

Wednesday Scramble

This seasonal, 9-hole golf scramble starts at 5:30 p.m. and is a fun event for all, and everyone has a chance of winning in this unique format. \$15 entry fee for members, \$30 non-members. Fee provides gift cards for the winners and \$5 ticket for each that is redeemable for food or beverage.

*All golf shop credit must be redeemed by December 31st of each year.
Any remaining credit will be deleted from the system each January 1st.*



Tee Time Reservations

Call the pro shop at 601-882-9030 to set up your tee time. Members can reserve tee times up to 30 days in advance. No more than five players in one group are allowed. All golfers are required to check in with the pro shop prior to play.

The Golf Shop

The pro shop stocks a wide variety of golf apparel, equipment and accessories year-round. The club's PGA Golf Professional also offers complimentary custom equipment fitting and allows members to demo the newest technology on the range and on the course. Our staff offers a full range of equipment repair including regripping, loft readjustments, and reshafting among other services.

Handicap System

If you are a Golf Member and want to play in our Club Tournaments you must establish a handicap in the World Handicap System. Stop in the Golf Shop and we can get you on your way to posting your scores. If you were a Member at another club before joining CCC, all we need is your GHIN # and we can transfer your USGA Handicap. To establish a handicap, you must post five 18-hole rounds, or post equivalent 9-hole rounds that will be combined. Members are billed \$30 annually.

Golf Instruction

Playing to your potential will greatly maximize your enjoyment of the game. Our creed is to "listen to your wants and needs and structure a game plan for your success." Whether it's through a formatted program or individual private lessons, the byproduct remains the same: satisfaction and enjoyment! Our PGA Professional, Corey Ruffin, is ready to get started.

TrackMan technology is used to analyze your swing, then start with small swing tips which culminate with a broader plan at the end of the lesson based on what works best for you during the session.

Junior Golf Camps

Corey offers multiple Junior Golf Camps each summer that includes golf instruction on the full swing, short game, rules and etiquette.

Snag Camps (Ages 5-12)

"Starting New at Golf" program designed to introduce beginners to the game of a lifetime. This revolutionary system provides all the equipment to make learning golf fun and easy.

Intermediate Golf (Ages 8-15)

Designed for those that have some experience playing 9 or 18 hole rounds but would like to learn more about the fundamentals of the golf swing and how to handle themselves on the golf course

Advanced Level (12 and up)

Designed for those who compete, have competed or are ready to compete in tournaments. Instruction will be largely based on TrackMan analysis and in-depth course management.

HOW CAN YOU IMPROVE YOUR GOLF GAME WITH TRACKMAN?

TrackMan provides instant feedback on data numbers on what the club is doing and the reaction of the ball at the same time. If you watch the PGA Tour Tournaments, you will oftentimes see the "shot tracer" showing the flight of the ball. This information is provided by TrackMan!

What Are TrackMan Numbers?

TrackMan technology provides the most accurate feedback in the industry. TrackMan numbers are divided into 2 main categories: ball flight data and club data. Knowing your TrackMan numbers, allows problem areas to be identified, resulting in fast improvement.

How TrackMan Works?

The TrackMan radar unit tracks the trajectory of your golf ball from launch to landing. The ability to measure the full ball flight is essential to produce the highest quality data. The radar can pick up valuable information about your club head, giving a precise picture of the club during ball impact. With this knowledge, you can easily determine how your club face or swing path needs to be adjusted.

Learn Exact Yardages for Your Clubs

Knowing how far you hit each club is paramount, so dialing in your feel for different yardages with your wedges is crucial to great scoring. TrackMan helps you learn what 60, 70, 80, 90 and 100 yards feels like so you can hit these shots on demand with a variety of spins and trajectories. TrackMan gives you immediate feedback on carry and total distance for every shot and will provide optimal numbers to give yourself a goal to reach within your skill level.

Maximize Your Driver

Hitting down on the ball with your driver is a huge distance killer. TrackMan gives you the data on how you are striking the ball a change from 5 degrees down to 5 degrees up can give you as much as 60 more yards with a 95mph swing speed.

Hit Your Preferred Ball Flight

TrackMan will give your numbers that are the DNA of your swing. Knowing how swing changes manipulate these numbers will help you achieve your desired ball flight.



Dress Code

Proper golf attire is required on the golf course, driving range and practice holes. Golf attire includes a collared shirt. Denim jeans or denim shorts are not appropriate attire on the practice facility or the golf course. Shorts are permitted at any time.

Driving Range and Practice Area

Practice and warm-up time are a vital part of game improvement and overall enjoyment of the game. During peak times the range will close each day at 7:00 p.m. to allow time to fully pick the range to prepare for the following day. The range will close at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday. Please note that these hours are subject to change with time changes, inclement weather, and the season. Removal of range balls from the practice area is prohibited.

Golf Course Etiquette

The following care of the Golf Course is expected of Members and their Guests:

- Repair all ball marks properly. Use a proper greens repair tool to close the damaged area so that no bare area exists. Do not lift the soil upward, but rather push the turf forward towards the front of the ball mark.
- There will be no practicing on any part of the golf course except at the designated practice areas. Do not hit multiple practice shots on the course.
- Pace of play is critical to enjoyment of our course. All players must maintain their position on the course relative to the group ahead and must play without undue delay. Allow faster groups to play through. Each 18-hole round should be completed within 4 hours and 15 minutes. The Marshal has the authority to keep play moving at the proper pace for players' enjoyment.
- Rake bunkers and leave rakes inside of bunkers.
- Remove broken tees from teeing ground.
- Place sand in all divots on tees and fairways. Do not overfill the divot or replace the divot, this will only slow down the healing process.
- The course and range are closed on Mondays.
- Jogging, bicycling, fishing or recreational walking is not permitted on the course or cart paths.

Cart Rules and Enforcement Procedures

The cart rules of the day must be followed at Castlewoods Country Club. These rules and the enforcement of them are vital to keep the turf on the golf course progressing in a positive manner. Please remember the following:

- Always check-in with the pro shop attendant so that you will know what the cart rule of the day is.
- When cart path only, carts must stay on the path at all times.
- When we are under the 90-degree rule, carts are allowed to be taken across the fairways at 90 degrees then turn and head back to the path at 90 degrees. Carts must remain on the path near the tee boxes, must stay off of the closely mown walking path near the tee boxes, on the path at all of the split rail fence on the course, and must return to the cart path at the white lines in the fairway. Do not park next to the white line as this stresses the turf.
- Two people to a cart when possible to help with wear and tear on the course.
- All operators of golf cart must be 16 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license.



The enforcement of the rules will take place in the following ways:

- Guests who ignore the rules of the day will be made to cease their round without a refund.
- Members who ignore the rules of the day will be assessed a \$50 fine on their next bill.

Private Cart Policies

- Check in at the pro shop even with a private cart. If you start on a hole other than one, please call the pro shop and let us know. If there is a group coming up behind you that started on one, they have the right of way to the next tee.
- Only one cart shall be allowed per member. Only people covered under the family membership are permitted to use that family's private cart.
- Dual membership on one cart is not allowed.
- Children under 16 may not operate a golf cart.
- When children move away from home or get married, they relinquish the right to use the cart.
- All private cart owners must have a membership that includes cart use. All private carts must have a club issued decal. Any member using a private cart that is not covered under their membership will be fined \$50.

Push/Pull Cart Policies

Push Carts should remain on the cart path in the vicinity of tees. At no time should the Push Cart be on the teeing ground. Push Carts should not be taken on the approaches or fringes of the Green. Push Carts should not be used within ten feet of any Green or Bunker. Whenever practical, Push Carts should remain on the cart path.

Beverage Cart

Weather permitting, our beverage cart service is provided Friday, Saturday and Sunday. It will be stocked with an assortment of food and beverages. Snacks and beverages are also available for purchase in the pro shop and grill prior play. No outside food or beverages are allowed on the course.

Sports and Activity Center Information

Pool

Our Sports and Activity Center provides a delightful family recreational experience. Our complex is exclusively for Castlewoods Country Club members and offers a safe & secure environment for you and your family to relax and play.

The NEW resort-style pool features a splash pad, slide, diving board, tanning ledges and tabletop seating. The pool is staffed with certified lifeguards. Summer evenings also play host to family themed pool parties and Flick-N-Float Movie Nights. The pool may be privately reserved by our members for that special event. We have an area for other activities including volleyball and cornhole.

The pool is open Tuesday - Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. and 10:30 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday. We are officially open Memorial Day through Labor Day but will open earlier and close later, weather and circumstances permitting. Enjoy the sun plus something to eat and drink at our full-service snack bar.



Fitness

Castlewoods Country Club provides members the convenience of 24-hour access for workout in our new fitness facility. It is equipped with treadmills, recumbent and spin bikes, ellipticals and strength training equipment to help you work toward achieving your health & wellness goals.

The fob reader for after-hours access is located on the left side of the building. If you or your family will be visiting the fitness area outside of our normal business hours you will need to request a key fob by sending email to toni@castlewoodscountryclub.com. State your member number and the first and last name of each qualified member/dependent(s) requesting after-hours access key fobs. The fobs will be set up in our system and available for pick up in our golf shop.

Tennis

With 6 lighted tennis courts, Castlewoods is proud to have our tennis program led by one of the south's most recognized tennis instructors, USPTA Certified Tennis Professional, Mark Elliott. Mark and his staff have the best program to offer given their playing background, coaching experience, and enthusiasm! They offer group, semi-private and private lessons for players of all ages from beginners to advanced. Stringing service is also available.

NOTE: Reservations for the 7:30 p.m. time slot must be booked no later than 12:00 p.m. on the day you are wanting to play at 7:30 so that we can staff accordingly.

Courts can be reserved two days in advance. Members can book courts beginning at 9 a.m. either in person or by calling 601-882-9549. Court reservations for Wednesday can be made on Sunday. Courts may not be booked back-to-back by the same member.

Court Cancellation Policy

We ask that all members reserving courts be mindful of the fact that we have numerous players wanting court reservations. If you are not able to play during the reservation time that you have scheduled, we require that you call us at least 12 hours prior to your reservation and cancel your court. If no one is in the building to take your call you will need to send your cancellation by email to toni@castlewoodscountryclub.com

No-Show Policy

If your tennis party is 15 minutes late to your booked court time, your court reservation will be forfeited and be given to other players. A written warning will be sent to the member that booked the court. If this violation occurs again a “no show” fee of \$10 will be automatically billed to the account of the member that booked the court.

Walk-On Policy

All members are encouraged to reserve courts in advance. However, please be aware that members who walk on a court without a reservation will be bumped by an existing reservation.

Castlewoods Country Club works closely with the MS Tennis Association to host USTA league play for men, women and juniors. We also host several ladies day leagues that play matches through the Jackson Tennis Ladies Association.

A weekly junior clinic is held during the school year on Tuesday from 4:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. for ages 6-12. The cost is \$12 and there is much flexibility in this group as there is no set sign ups. Parents can bring their children on any given Tuesday; reservations are not required. It is a great way to test out your child's interest in a fun but learning environment.

During the summer months, we host summer tennis camps for our juniors. Also, throughout the year, we have mixers and social events for our tennis members to enjoy that include match play, music, food and drinks!
